

Altar Flowers

Steps to Sign-up:

- If you would like to donate flower arrangements for use in our worship services, please call Anderson Davis at the main church line (919)-834-6259 or email her at adavis@ccral.org to see what dates are available and to reserve a spot.
- Once you have reserved an arrangement date/location you will need to contact the florist to reserve their services. You will work directly with them to reserve the date, coordinate style and delivery, and provide payment. Please note that certain Sundays have liturgical guidance as to how the arrangements are to be composed – these specifications should be communicated with the florist.
- The liners for the containers which will hold the flowers on the altar are to be picked up by the florist. Flowers should be delivered to the church by 9am on Saturday. While the florist usually delivers the flowers themselves, you are responsible for making sure this delivery arrives.
- If you are honoring or remembering more than one person with this gift, we ask that you not list more than five or six people. These details will be communicated when reserving a spot with Anderson and confirmed with you before our bulletins are printed.

Once services conclude on Sunday, worship flowers will be removed by the Flower Guild who rearranges the flowers and delivers them to parishioners experiencing joys or sorrows, as part of our Pastoral Care ministry.

Church Altar – 2 Main Arrangements: Two large arrangements in the main sanctuary (total approximate cost \$500)

Church Altar – The Rosa Vase: One smaller center arrangement on the main sanctuary altar, beneath the cross, and between the two larger altar arrangements. **This arrangement must coordinate in style with the two main arrangements on the altar that day and therefore will need to be arranged by the same florist.** (total approximate cost \$150)

Chapel Altar: 2 arrangements on the Chapel Altar, will be moved to the Sanctuary for the 5:00 PM Holy Eucharist

***Altar Flowers may be no higher than the altar cross – the maximum height, including vases, from the table to the top of the arrangement is 30 inches in the chapel and 44 inches in the church**

You may use any florist you wish, the above estimates are from Kelly Odom Flowers, who provides arrangements regularly for services in our church and is familiar with our needs and operations.
